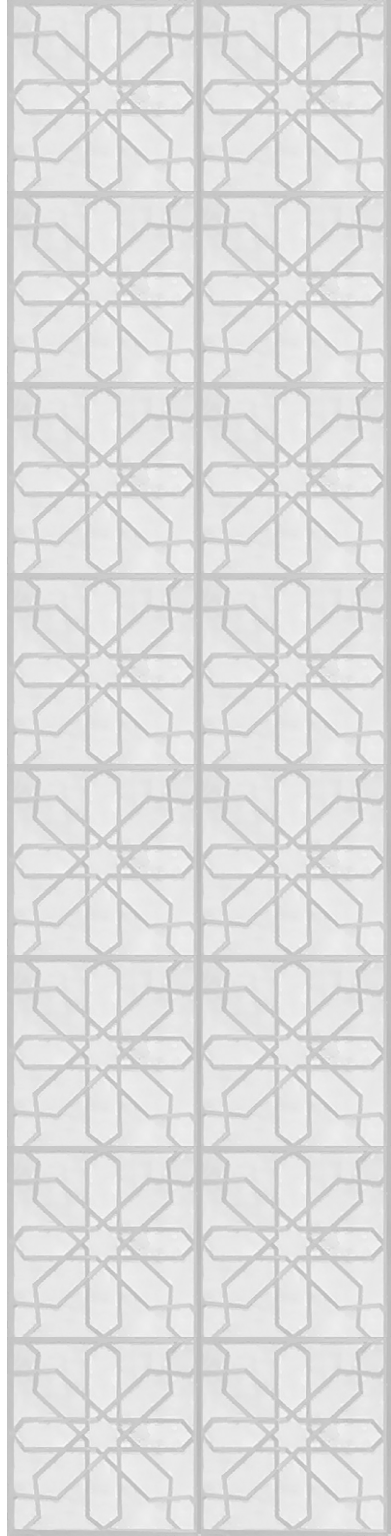

Foreword

Youth Parliament Pakistan is a platform for Pakistani Youth patterned after the National Assembly of Pakistan with 60 members from all over the country. The Youth Parliament membership is selected from across the country for a one-year term.

PILDAT formed the first-ever Youth Parliament of Pakistan in the year 2007. After the successful completion of the three Youth Parliament terms in 2007, 2008 and 2009, PILDAT has now launched the fourth term: **Youth Parliament Pakistan 2012**.

Establishment and facilitation of the Youth Parliament is part of PILDAT's focus on Youth in the country and Youth's awareness education and training in the norms of politics and democracy in the country. PILDAT strongly feels that sustainable democracy and the sustainability of sound democratic institutions in Pakistan is not possible without youth's involvement in the democratic and political process even if this involvement is simply as a citizen or voter.

The Youth Parliament Pakistan has its own **2-Party system**, the **Leader of the House** and the **Leader of the Opposition**, a **Youth Cabinet**, a **Shadow Cabinet** and **Parliamentary Committees**.

The **Youth Parliament Pakistan** project is conceived, planned and implemented by **PILDAT**. It is supported by the **Danish International Development Agency, Government of Denmark** as recognition of the importance of young people's involvement in democracy and democratic practices.

This Introductory Book presents details about the Youth Parliament Project and the selected members. The project of Youth Parliament has continued to benefit greatly from the experience in 2007, 2008 and 2009. We at PILDAT, as the Secretariat of Youth Parliament Pakistan, look forward to receiving feedback and input of young members and other stakeholders to enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of this exercise in the future also.

Why a Youth Parliament?

Pakistan needs to strengthen its democratic institutions and inculcate democratic culture in the society. We need to discourage extremist tendencies and lack of tolerance for others' beliefs and views and strengthen the rule of law.

Open and informed debate on issues facing the society should be promoted. The society should develop tools, mechanisms and systems which can facilitate the exposure of democratic system to its citizens from an early stage.

Youth Parliament Pakistan, therefore, has been conceived, designed and implemented by PILDAT as a forum for Young Pakistanis where they can learn the values of dialogue and tolerance and understand how democracy and democratic institutions can and should work in Pakistan.

Youth Parliament Pakistan

The question Pakistani society faces is that how do we deepen our understanding of parliamentary democracy, and uphold and advance its practice in Pakistan? **PILDAT**, as an organisation committed to strengthening democracy and democratic institutions in Pakistan, feels that it is necessary to engage the Pakistani Youth in healthy discourse and expose them to democratic traditions and culture so that they may be groomed as a civilised, tolerant and peaceful citizens. The concept of Youth Parliament emerged as a way for young people to “learn by doing,” through taking part in Youth Parliament. It was felt that practice on the benches of a mock Parliament can be useful in deciding how to become a more active citizen, either inside or outside formal politics.

The project of Youth Parliament is seen as a way to inculcate democratic culture in Pakistani Youth and to facilitate free but structured expression of their views. The Youth Parliament is also seen as a key towards achieving the objective of support for democracy and growth and sustenance of democratic institutions in Pakistan.

The first-ever Youth Parliament Pakistan, established in 2007 for a one-year term, proved as a great platform through which a representative section of the Youth of Pakistan practiced and experienced life under a political and parliamentary spotlight. The young members of Youth Parliament Pakistan chose political association,

elected their Youth Prime Minister and Leader of the Opposition, a Youth Cabinet and a Shadow Cabinet, debated public policy issues, worked in Parliamentary Committees and gave their detailed input to some of their key policies of the Government of Pakistan such as the Draft Youth Policy, proposed legislation on Provincial Autonomy and a host of other issues. The young members, drawn from across a cross-section of socio-political and economic spectrum of Pakistan, learnt and practiced how to prepare and move legislation, how to enlist support of their fellow members on their bills and resolutions in the House and how to reach consensus and compromise through the use of conversation, dialogue and understanding of the others' concerns, views and perspectives.

The vibrant membership of the Youth Parliament Pakistan 2007 concluded its work gloriously through preparing and launching a **Youth Manifesto 2007** to articulate Pakistani Youth's perspective on key issues ranging from Provincial Autonomy to Local Government System; Free and Fair Elections to Law and Order; Combating Extremism and Terrorism to Economy and Agricultural Development; International Relations to Education and Health, etc. in addition to Environment, Culture, Women, Recreation and Sport, Juvenile Justice and Empowerment of Youth in Rural Areas.

Objectives

The specific objectives of Youth Parliament Pakistan are to educate Pakistani Youth about politics and democracy and to demonstrate to them how Parliaments are able:

- to legislate;
- to debate matters of national and international concern;
- to demand accountability from those in government;
- to discuss legislation in committee;
- to change government without recourse to civil disorder; and
- to make and enforce their own rules of conduct.

In addition, we expect the Youth Parliament to become a useful forum to voice views of the Youth about a range of international and national issues. The debates in the Youth Forum will not only help the young members in their personal development as a useful citizen, it will also serve the purpose of articulating views of the youth on vital issues facing the nation and conveying these to the government and Society at large.

Profile of YPP Batch 4

The selection process for the Batch 4, like earlier batches, based on merit, has been led by an independent Steering Committee.

Gender Make-up

Out of the 60 member batch, 44 are male while 16 are female.

Average Age

The average age in the 4th batch is 23 years.

Party Representation

In the fourth successive batch, the Blue Party forms a majority with 78% membership opting for its membership while 22% members have joined the Green Party.

Provincial Representation

The Youth Parliament Pakistan consists of 28 members from Punjab, 12 members from Sindh, 7 from KP, 5 from Balochistan, 3 from Islamabad Capital Territory, 2 each from FATA and AJK while 1 member from Gilgit Baltistan.

Key Features of the Youth Parliament Pakistan 2012

As a model Parliament for young people, the Youth Parliament Pakistan is patterned after the National Assembly of Pakistan although its membership is smaller than that of the National Assembly. Wherever possible, the Youth Parliament follows the rules of procedures as close to the National Assembly as practical. However, practices from other Parliaments are adopted to expose Pakistani Youth to better Parliamentary practices.

Membership

The total membership of Youth Parliament is 60. The seats have been divided on the basis of population criteria used by the National Assembly of Pakistan, however one seat each is given to Azad Jammu and Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan in the Youth Parliament Pakistan. The breakdown of the membership is below:

ages of 18-29 years on January 01, 2012 were eligible to apply for membership of the Youth Parliament.

Secretariat of the Youth Parliament

As the project implementer, **PILDAT** is the Secretariat of the Youth Parliament.

Members' Political Affiliation

There is no bar on the actual political affiliation of the members of the Youth Parliament. However, Youth Parliament has two mock political parties: the **Blue Party** and the **Green Party** and members are asked to join either one of the two political parties for the purpose of Youth Parliament. Joining one of the parties is obligatory for members.

Life of the Youth Parliament

Youth Parliament will run for one year

Minimum Work Days

The Youth Parliament will meet for at least 25 days in a year.

Selection of Participants

The process of selection of participants for the Youth Parliament has been multi-tiered and involved the following steps:

1. Placing of Advertisement in nationwide editions of two of the largest circulating English and Urdu daily newspapers of the country.
2. Submission of Expression of Interest by interested candidates
3. Internal review of Expressions of Interest and short-listing for Interviews
4. Calls for Interviews to short-listed candidates
5. Selection Interviews by Youth Parliament Steering Committee
6. Selection Calls and Invitations for becoming Members of Youth Parliament

Selection Criteria

Following criteria for selection has been adopted:

1. Interested candidates should be citizens of Pakistan or holders of Pakistani Origin Card in the case of Overseas Pakistanis
2. Age of interested candidates should not be less than 18 years and more than 29 years on January 01, 2012
3. Interested candidates should be able to read and write Urdu
4. There should be no criminal record against interested candidates in Pakistan or abroad

Efforts have been made to ensure that all provinces and territories of Pakistan are represented in the finally selected members including adequate representation to women and persons belonging to religious minorities.

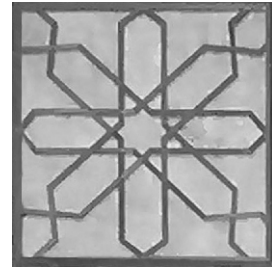

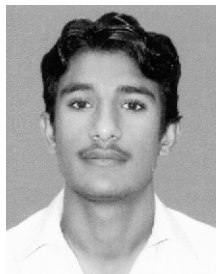
YP04-BALUCHISTAN02 **Malik Rehan**
