# Overview of the situation:

Balochistan is at its worse situation since its accession to the Pakistan. Baloch people in this country have received only military operations and nothing else from the federation. In recent past when state lunched a large operation in Murri and Bugti areas in 2004 and onwards, there were hundred and thousand of people killed and nearly about 0.2 million were displaced and this operation is said to be the game changing for this province. When in 2006 Nawab Akbar khan was killed in the mountains in a military operation, in reaction of his assassination Baloch people reacted by political as well as militancy means. Both type of reaction were not acceptable to the state, and state started its reaction on the situations by means of extra judicial killings of political workers, students including women and children.

Though in past killings of Baloch people were on but a difference in this was that they were killed in reaction but now majority of the people whose bullet riddled bodies are found are innocent and were students in the colleges schools, they doctors engineers as well as teachers.

The problem of mutilated and bullet riddled bodies are as fuel on the fire. Political activists are forcefully being disappeared first and after a time period of week to years their mutilated bodies are found in the mountains road sides under the bridges etc.

The families of the missing person are of the view that's its all the state and security agencies who are killing the missing person, majority of them has launched FIR against the state and agencies.

Situation is getting worse by day every week bodies are being found and there does not pass a single day when an innocent person is not forcefully disappeared.

In Balochistan on reaction of a single body found and disappearance the whole province is closed for days and week. The impact of a body on a Baloch is unimaginable.

The anti state views has penetrated to the children and in such a situation the only recommendation to the state be to remove the forces of which Baloch people don't want and dialogue shall be the first and last option.

# Express tribune report on the situation

QUETTA/KARACHI: Saturday was International Human Rights Day, though in Pakistan the focus remained squarely within its own borders and on one province in particular.

The Human Rights Commission of Pakistan observed the day in solidarity with the people of Balochistan. Taking a look at recent statistics and hearing the stories from some of those affected, one understands why.

According to an HRCP report, as many as 225 bullet-riddled bodies of missing persons were found between July 2010 and November 2011. The Voice for Baloch Missing Persons (VFBMP) puts the toll even higher, at 236, and says that all the victims had direct or indirect political affiliation with Baloch nationalist parties or student organisations.

Most worryingly, the numbers are getting worse. 107 new cases of missing persons have been reported this year, out of which 97 people have been found dead in different locations in the province.

“The writ of the government does not exist in Balochistan” says Tahir Hussain, chairman of the HRCP Balochistan chapter.

Hussain also pinpoints the fragile existence of minority communities in the province.

“Minorities are compelled to migrate from Balochistan as they have become a soft target for kidnapping for ransom. At least 100 families belonging to the Hindu community have migrated from Balochistan solely because of kidnapping for ransom,” he says. In addition, as many as 80 Shias were killed in targeted killing and bomb blasts this year.

Settlers are also at risk. “Over 100 families, who are Punjabi and Urdu-speaking, have left the province because they were vulnerable to targeted killing by separatist groups,” he said.

Even those defending such minorities and standing up for human rights are under threat. Two activists – Naeem Sabir and Mohammad Siddiq Edo – were kidnapped and their bodies turned up this year,” the HRCP report states.

Mir Asghar Bangulzai, the uncle of VFBMP chairman Nasurllah Baloch, was kidnapped in June 2000 by a group of armed men from Quetta and released after a few days.

However, Bangulzai, a tailor by profession, was again abducted in October 2001. A decade has passed and the family is still in the dark regarding his whereabouts. They blame the security forces for the kidnapping.

“You cannot imagine the kind of pain a family goes through when their loved one has gone missing, and at the same time mutilated bodies surface almost every week,” says Nasurllah Baloch.

The HRCP report says that practices of enforced disappearance started during the Musharraf regime in early 2000 and have steadily intensified. “The situation has gone from bad to worse with the discovery of mutilated bodies. Ironically there is no investigation in any of the cases,” says Tahir Hussain.

It adds that security forces are involved in practices of enforced disappearances, while some Baloch armed groups are behind the targeted killing of innocent settlers.

HRCP Balochistan urged the government to investigate the involvement of politicians and security forces. HRCP also demanded that a judicial inquiry be launched into the kidnapping and dumping the bodies of political opponents. Security forces, however, categorically reject the allegations of foul-play in the province

### **HRCP highlights Balochistan**

Addressing the media at Karachi’s press club on Saturday, HRCP Chairperson Zohra Yusuf appealed to the government to address the sense of alienation felt by the people of Balochistan.

Saying the issue was “of foremost concern in the country today,” Yusuf commemorated the day by saying that people in Balochistan “believe that the government of Pakistan is doing injustice with them and such sentiments are increasing.”

However, relatives of Baloch missing persons announced that they would not take part in the rally organised by HRCP Balochistan to observe the human rights day. “The HRCP does not have any role to play for the safe recovery of missing persons,” said Nasurllah Baloch. “The organization has prioritised other issues, giving lesser attention to the gross violation of human rights. We are holding a separate rally to highlight our plight.”

At the conference, the chairperson repeatedly criticized the government for their role in the violation of Balochistan’s human rights.

# Recommendations:

“You cannot imagine the kind of pain a family goes through when their loved one has gone missing, and at the same time mutilated bodies surface almost every week,”

According to an HRCP report, as many as 225 bullet-riddled bodies of missing persons were found between July 2010 and November 2011. The Voice for Baloch Missing Persons (VFBMP) puts the toll even higher, at 236, and says that all the victims had direct or indirect political affiliation with Baloch nationalist parties or student organisations. (Tribune Dec, 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012)

- 1) A new Fact finding commission shall be formed immediately which shall comprise a judge of Supreme Court, A renowned person from HRCP, the chairman for voice for Baloch missing person, and Chief justice of Balochistan high court. The commission shall visit all the districts of Balochistan and collect evidence from the people whose relatives' bullet riddled bodies were found and who's relatives' are missing. The commission shall meet the person who were missing and are now traced. The commission shall start its work immediately after its formation and within 90 days of time frame it shall give its report and view point on the Bullet riddled bodies and missing persons. The main task of commission shall be finding the culprits behind the bullet riddled bodies and stopping the killings and no more missing persons (Forced disappearance).
- 2) General amnesty be declared, and cases against the leaders and students shall be finished.
- 3) “Compensation in monetary terms can never be a remedial measure for a mother whose innocent son is killed”. The federal government shall announce Rs. 2.5 million to each family whose family member is killed. The federal government shall provide free education till higher

education to the children of that family and give jobs to the people who are jobless in those families.

- 4) The culprits behind the bullet riddled bodies and missing person shall be trialed and if they are found they shall be executed.
- 5) If any security agency personnel is found involved in these activities in Balochistan of which families of Baloch missing person are pointing out then they shall be court marshal as per rules and also be trialed in courts. The chain of command shall be identified and traced from where such orders where given.
- 6) Missing person shall be produced by the law enforcement agencies immediately.
- 7) Internally displaced persons (IDPs) of Bugti and Marri areas shall be resettled and shall be compensated with handsome money.
- 8) No go areas shall be declared free and free movement shall be allowed
- 9) Role of security agencies be finished in Balochistan.
- 10) Frontier corps shall be brought to the positions of 1990s and the troops shall be reduced and FC shall only operate in the border areas and the main task of FC shall be to stop drug trafficking from Balochistan.
- 11) Local Balochistan constabulary, Balochistan police and Balochistan levies force should be equipped like F.C and be deployed to the current positions of FC.
- 12) FC camps and cantonments in the district head Quarters shall be converted into schools, colleges, universities and hospitals.
- 13) Check posts in whole Balochistan shall be abolished and patrolling on the Highways shall be done by the Levies and police force.
- 14) Local groups like Al Badr o Al Shams who are operating in Balochistan shall be finished.
- 15) No force shall be used on the innocent people and who are fighting on reactionary basis.

Dialogue shall be the first and also the last option.
