



[TO BE INTRODUCED IN THE YOUTH PARLIAMENT OF PAKISTAN]

A

BILL

WHEREAS, it is expedient to introduce this bill for protection of human rights for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as under:-

1. **Short title and commencement:-**

(1) This Act may be called Pakistan Human rights Act, 2012.

(2) It shall come into force at once

1. Everyone who advocates or promotes genocide is guilty of an indictable offence and liable To imprisonment for a term not exceeding ten years.

2.

Whoever, by words, either spoken or written, or by signs, or by visible representations or otherwise, promotes or incites, or attempts to promote or incite, on grounds of religion, race, Place of both, residence. language, caste or community or any other ground whatsoever, disharmony or feelings of enmity, hatred or ill-will between different religious, racial, language

or regional groups or castes or communities; or

commits, or incites any other person to commit, any act which is prejudicial to the maintenance of harmony between different religious, racial, language or regional groups or castes or communities which is likely to disturb public tranquility; or

4.

organizes, or incites any other person to organize, and exercise, movement, intending that the participants in any such activity shall use or be trained to use criminal force or violence, against any religious, racial, language or regional group or caste of community or any group of person is likely to cause fear or alarm or a feeling of insecurity amongst members of such religious, racial, language or regional group or caste or community. shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to ten years and with fine if five million rupees.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this act is to give every citizen of Pakistan safety from the ongoing innumerable Hate Crime incidents. Such incidents are tarnishing the country's image internationally and it is the need of the hour to protect every citizen of Pakistan irrespective of their caste creed and colour.
